The lines will go from the pole and around the trees, then into the building on the south side. The current well and pump were most likely installed during the 1950s. We are currently awaiting estimates from Stothoff, Maxwell, Calaloose and Sentry Pump. A letter was received from the County asking what could be done with 50 percent of the amount requested in the grant application. The grant seems to be coming, just don't know how much.
