WHEREAS, the Township Committee further finds that Nisivoccia Consulting, LLC, the firm that is the current Information Technology Consultant for the Township of Mansfield is well qualified to provide the necessary mobile data terminals (laptops for police vehicles), computer server and provide the necessary consulting services required by the police department; and

WHEREAS, Nisivoccia Consulting, LLC has submitted the following documentation in compliance with the awarding of a contact under the New Jersey Pay to Play Law within 10 days of the awarding of the contract;

- a. Business Entity Disclosure Certification for Non-Fair and Open Contracts which certifies that Nisivoccia Consulting has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Mansfield in the previous one year,

WHEREAS, if a contract exceeds \$17,500, the Temporary QPA is permitted under the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law and Pay to Pay Law to award the contract if the vendor has submitted the aforementioned documentation; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for this contract in the Capital Reserve Account, Account Number 3-04-226-55-000-000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Mansfield, County of Warren, State of New Jersey does hereby award a contract to Nisivoccia Consulting, LLC in the amount of \$18,400.00 to provide mobile data terminals for police vehicles (laptops for police vehicles), computer server and consulting service to the police department, and Nisivoccia Consulting, LLC is in compliance with the New Jersey Pay to Play Law per the above.
